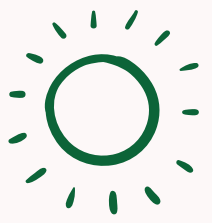




# SANSEVERIA

## Care Guide



Provide bright, indirect light if possible. Snake plants will tolerate lower light (but will grow slower and may need less water)



Water sparingly. Typically, every few weeks once the soil is completely dried out. Cut back in the winter to around once a month.



Over-watering is a sure way to kill these. Provide a pot with good drainage.

**Also known as "Mother in Law's Tongue" or "Snake Plant". An easy care houseplant that come in a variety of color, sizes, and variegations.**
