

FIDDLE LEAF FIG Care Sheet

Avoid overwatering - you will water roughly once every 7-10 days (when the top 2" of soil is dry). Provide a well drained pot and make sure to water thoroughly where water drains from the bottom of the pot.

Lots of bright but indirect light makes them happy! Avoid direct sunlight that might burn leaves.

The key to Fiddle Leafs (and all Figs) is consistency. Avoid placing near drafty areas such as windows and floor/ceiling vents. Don't move your Fiddle around - find the perfect spot and let it happily live there. Turn pot slightly when you water to avoid it leaning towards the sunlight. On occasion, wipe leaves down with a wet cloth to remove dust. FLF's enjoy being somewhat root bound.

Fiddle Leaf Figs have been a hot houseplant item for several years. It's easy to see why with the large striking leaves! Some varieties have smaller leaves & growth habits.
