

# Houseplants for Low Light

These plants will tolerate lower light conditions but will grow slower, need less water, & will sometimes get thin. Low light should not be confused with “no light”. If no light is available, then we suggest an artificial grow light.

## Sansevieria

Also known as Mother in Laws tongue, the dark leaved varieties are best suited for low light. Very easy care. Water only when soil has dried completely out around once every 4-6 weeks.



## Peace Lily

Old time plant with white blooms that is easy to care for. Water every 1-2 weeks when the top inch of soil dries out. The traditional green is best for low light.



## Heartleaf Green Philodendron

Easy care vining plant with green heart shaped leaves. Water every 1-2 weeks when top 2" of soil dries out. Choose the green variety for best low light tolerance.



## Parlor / Neanthe Bella Palm

Not a true Palm but with the appearance of one. Easier to grow houseplant that needs water every 1-2 weeks once the top 2" of soil has dried out.



## ZZ Plant

A super easy care plant that tolerates neglect, low light, & low water. Water only when the soil has completely dried out every 4-6 weeks.



## Lucky Bamboo

This Dracaena plant likes to have plenty of water but will tolerate lower light conditions. It looks like a piece of Bamboo! Keep the container it is in filled with water and pebbles.
